Who has access to your information?

Your information remains securely with Kate Stannard. We will not sell or rent your information to third parties. We will not share your information with third parties for marketing purposes. We will not pass on your information without your consent unless we are required to do so by law, for example, by a court order or for the purposes of prevention of fraud or other crimes.
